

CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF KINROSS

RESOLUTION

ADOPTING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR WATER AND SEWER USE AND SERVICES
AS PROVIDED FOR WITHIN THE KINROSS CHARTER TOWNSHIP
WATER AND SEWER ORDINANCES

At a regular meeting of the Township Board of the Charter Township of Kinross, County of Chippewa, State of Michigan, held at 4884 W. Curtis St., in said Township on March 18, 2002, at 7:30 P.M. Local Time.

WHEREAS, Kinross Charter Township has recognized the need to set, and if necessary, adjust a fee schedule for the use and services as defined in the Kinross Charter Township Water and Sewer Ordinances, also known as Ordinance #1.123 and #1.124, to offset the expenses incurred, services rendered and/or to facilitate the sound operation of the municipal water and sewer system; and

WHEREAS, in conformity with the Charter Township Act, specifically Public Act 359 of 1947, as amended, Charter Townships were vested with the authority to recover expenses incurred in the facilitation of an ordinance; and

WHEREAS, in conformity with Public Act 178 of 1939, as amended, Charter Townships were vested with the authority to charge users for services and recover expenses incurred in the facilitation of a water and sewer system and impose liens for non-payment thereof; and

WHEREAS, A fee schedule, based on the needs of the system and the community, has been established by the Township Board, to facilitate the sound operations of the system according to the Kinross Charter Township Water and Sewer Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Kinross Charter Township also retains the right to alter these rates as the need may arise from time to time, with or without notice; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the following rate schedule has been declared adopted by the Kinross Charter Township Board and shall hereafter be applied to all users of the municipal system as required by the Water and Sewer Ordinances.

Rate schedule effective date April 1, 2002 :

Monthly billing due date, pursuant to Article 10, Sec1 of the Water and Sewer Ordinances, shall be: The 20th of each month.

The O,M&R charge shall be the monthly sum of the Capacity Charge and the Commodity Charge.

* "Capacity Charge" is a flat or minimum charge based upon the size of the Customer's water meter.

** "Commodity Charge" is a varying charge, with a minimum, based upon the Customer's actual monthly water consumption as measured by the Customer's water meter.

WATER

*Capacity & Charges:

Five eighths & three quarters inch capacity (5/8" to 3/4") meter at three dollars and seventy five cents (\$3.75) per month

One inch (1") meter at six dollars (\$6.00) per month

One to one and one half inch capacity (1" to 1 1/2") meter at twelve dollars (\$12.00) per month

Two inch (2") meter at eighteen dollars (\$18.00) per month

Three inch (3") meter at four-eight dollars (\$48.00) per month

Four inch (4") meter at seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) per month

Six inch (6") meter at one hundred-fifty dollars (\$150.00) per month

Eight inch (8") meter at two hundred-forty dollars (\$240.00) per month

Ten inch (10") meter at four hundred-eighteen dollars (\$418.00) per month

Ten inch Combo (11") meter at four hundred thirty six dollars (\$436.00) per month

**Commodity Charge:

One dollar ninety cents (\$1.90) per month

Plus one dollar (\$1.00) per one thousand (1000) gallons of usage in excess of six thousand (6000) gallons per month

SEWER

*Capacity & Charges:

Five eighths & three quarters inch capacity (5/8" to 3/4") meter at five dollars and twenty-five cents (\$5.25) per month

One inch (1") meter at eight dollars and forty cents (\$8.40) per month

One to one and one half inch capacity (1" to 1 1/2") meter at sixteen dollars and eighty cents (\$16.80) per month

Two inch (2") meter at twenty-five dollars and twenty cents (\$25.20) per month

Three inch (3") meter at sixty-seven dollars and twenty cents (\$67.20) per month

Four inch (4") meter at one hundred and five dollars (\$105.00) per month

Six inch (6") meter at two hundred and ten dollars (\$210.00) per month

Eight inch (8") meter at three hundred and thirty-six dollars (\$336.00) per month

Ten inch (10") meter at five hundred and twenty-two dollars (\$522.00) per month

Ten inch Combo (11") meter at five hundred and forty-seven dollars and twenty cents (\$547.20) per month

**Commodity Charge:

Minimum Charge is five dollars and five cents (\$5.05) per month

Plus two dollars and seventy-five cents (\$2.75) per one thousand (1,000) gallons of usage in excess of six thousand (6,000) gallons, per month.

"Above Normal Sewage Strength Charges"

Each customer that discharges Sewage, exceeding "Normal Strength Sewage", will pay appropriate surcharges for treatment of the excess strengths as provided for in Article 9, Section 3 of the Sewer Ordinance in the following manner:

Biochemical Oxygen Demand (in excess of three hundred and fifteen milligrams per liter (315 mg/l) at fifty-three cents (\$0.53) per pound.

Suspended Solids in excess of two hundred and seventy milligrams per liter (270 mg/l) at forty-two cents (\$0.42) per pound.

Total Phosphorus in excess of eight milligrams per liter (8 mg/l) at four dollars and twenty cents (\$4.20) per pound.

Allowable pH levels shall not exceed pH levels of less than six and one half (6.5) or greater than nine (9.0).

OTHER CHARGES

"New Account Fee" as provided for in Article 10, Section 4: Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).

"Name Change, Same Account Fee" as provided for in Article 10, Section 4: Fifteen dollars (\$15.00).

"Connection Charge" as provided for in Article 9, Section 6 of the Sewer Ordinance and Article 10, Section 5 of the Water Ordinance: Actual cost of installing and inspecting a Service Connection plus two hundred dollars (\$200).

"Penalty Charge" (late fee) as provided for in Article 10, Section 1 of the Sewer Ordinance and Article 11, Section 1 of the Water Ordinance: one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50).

"Lessee Liability Affidavit Fee" as provided for in Article 10, Section 3 of the Sewer Ordinance and Article 11, Section 3 of the Water Ordinance (Security Deposit): Fifty dollars (\$50.00) for Sewer and twenty dollars (\$20.00) for Water.

"Reconnection Deposit" (after failure to pay) as provided for in Article 10, Section 8, of the Sewer Ordinance and Article 11, Section 8, of the Water Ordinance: One hundred dollars (\$100.00).

"Meter Testing Deposit" as provided for in Article 5, Section 8 of the Water Ordinance: Fifteen dollars (\$15.00).

"Fire Hydrant Use Deposit" as provided for in Article 6, Section 1 of the Water Ordinance: Fifty dollars (\$50.00)

"Lateral Fee" as defined in the definitions section of the Water and Sewer Ordinances: Zero dollars (\$0).

"Meter Fee" as defined in the definitions section of the Water and Sewer Ordinances: Zero dollars (\$0).

"Miscellaneous Customer Fees and Charges" as provided for in Article 9, Section 7, of the Sewer Ordinance and Article 10, Section 6, of the Water Ordinance: Zero dollars (\$0).
