For self-parking (max. \$14.50/day), turn right into the Amway Grand Plaza ramp. If you wish to utilize valet parking (\$17/day), turn left into the hotel motor lobby drive.

From I-196 East: Use the Ottawa Avenue/Downtown exit (Exit 77C), keeping right at the fork. Turn right onto Michigan Avenue, then left onto Monroe Avenue. Drive past the DeVos Place and the Amway Grand Plaza, turning right onto Pearl Street. For self-parking (max. \$14.50/day), turn left into the Amway Grand Plaza ramp. If you wish to utilize valet parking (\$17/day), turn right into the hotel motor lobby drive.

Overnight Lodging

Hotel rooms are available on-site. To obtain discounted rates on lodging, you must be registered for the Institute.
